

# Idaho's 2020 Delegate Selection Process Timeline

## Critical 2020 Dates:

- **March 31<sup>st</sup>:** Last day for an applicant who cannot attend the April 4<sup>th</sup> County Delegate Selection Caucus to apply to be a Delegate to the state convention
- **June 5<sup>th</sup>:** Deadline to file a statement of candidacy with IDP to be a National Delegate

### 1<sup>st</sup> Stage: Presidential Primary — March 10<sup>th</sup>

- All Registered Democrats & Unaffiliated Voters can participate
- Can vote absentee, early and on election day— at regular polling locations
- Delegates Apportioned off primary results will be published on March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020

Only candidates who received 15% of the vote in a given county's March 10<sup>th</sup> Primary will be able to receive Delegates at the County Delegate Selection Caucus. Each candidate's delegate totals be published on March 13

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage: County Delegate Selection Caucus — April 4<sup>th</sup>

- The sole purpose of the County Delegate Selection Caucus is to elect Delegates to the State Convention
- Those who wish to participate must be Registered Democrats; you do not need to be a candidate for Delegate
- If a Democrat will not be able to attend in-person, but wishes to be a Delegate to the convention, they must submit their intention by March 31<sup>st</sup> at 5:30pm MT
- Delegates will be apportioned to Presidential Candidates off primary results on March 10, 2020
- Attendees may only participate in one Presidential Candidate's delegate selection vote
- You do not have to caucus for the candidate you voted for in the primary

*\*Each County Delegate Selection Caucus will occur April 4th at 2:00 pm MT.*

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Stage: Idaho State Convention — June 4<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> · Boise

- Delegates elected at the County Delegate Selection Caucuses can vote & participate
- Delegates to the National Convention are elected; *only Presidential Candidates who received 15% or greater statewide can receive Delegates to the National Convention*
